**TABLE OF FEES, PAYMENTS AND SUMS** fixed and settled under section 34 of the Burial Act 1852 by the PARISH COUNCIL OF FOWLMERE acting as the BURIAL AUTHORITY for the PARISH OF FOWLMERE.

Interments must comply with the Terms and Conditions of Fowlmere Cemetery. A signed copy of the Terms and Conditions must be lodged with the Parish Clerk before a plot can be sold, an interment / burial can take place, or a stone / monument can be placed in the cemetery. The terms and conditions must be adhered to by the families, funeral directors and stone masons involved.

The fees indicated for the various heads of items listed below DO NOT include the digging of the grave.
