Road Closure: St Marys Walk (19<sup>th</sup>), Champions Close (19<sup>th</sup>), Johns Close (19<sup>th</sup>), Isons Close (19<sup>th</sup>), Jacksons Way (20<sup>th</sup>), Ryecroft Lane (20<sup>th</sup>)

I am writing to advise you of a Road Closure that will be happening shortly, in order to facilitate essential carriageway maintenance.

At the time of this letter, currently scheduled to begin Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021 for approximately three days – not weekend- (Dependent on Weather) – Carriageway Micro Asphalt Surface Treatment.

Whilst the work is in progress, during operational hours, the road could be closed between approximately 7.30am to 6pm, and vehicular access will be restricted. In order for the contractor to complete the work with minimum disruption, it is essential that no vehicles are parked on the road. Access to properties within the closure area will be possible, but are subject to working conditions, and delays are to be expected.
